

HIGH ACHIEVERS' PROGRAM (HAP) INFORMATION

Dear Parents and Carers,

If your child has been **accepted** into Berwick College for 2025, you are now able to submit an expression of interest for our highly sought after High Achievers' Program, via the link below.

The Select Entry Testing Day is being held at Berwick College on **Saturday, 3rd August, 2024.**

Parents need to register and pay for the Edutest, online through this URL: <https://aus.edutest.com.au/D/?t=1i8d9mu2>
Registration, together with a payment of \$90 must be received no later than Monday, 29th July.

Candidates should arrive at the College Library, Berwick College, 65-69 Manuka Rd, Berwick at 8.45 am (15 minutes prior to the 9.00 am examination start time).

Students are only permitted to bring the following items to the testing: two black or blue pens, two 2B or HB pencils, one pencil sharpener and one eraser. Students are permitted to bring with them a drink and a small snack for the break. Students are not permitted to have with them any books, papers, measuring or calculating instruments of any kind, including calculator watches, watches that beep, or mobile phones. A form of identification is required. Acceptable forms of identification are:

- Student card (issued by your school)
- Current student travel card
- A recent class photograph with name clearly shown
- Passport (recent)
- Current library card (with photo).

Latecomers will not be permitted to sit the examination.

Parents or Carers will not be able to accompany their children to the examination rooms or to see their children during the break. Children will be available for collection at approximately 12 noon.

Illness:

- Students should not attend an on-site examination if they are ill. Should a student be coughing or sneezing consistently during a test, a decision will be made by the school as to whether to remove the student from the testing.
- If your child is not able to attend the examination due to severe illness or misadventure, please contact Edutest on registrar@edutest.com.au prior to 9:00am on the test day. Please also obtain a medical certificate specifically covering the date of the examination and provide this to Edutest as an email attachment by no later than 12noon on the next business day.
- The opportunity for a possible alternate testing date can then be explored. There is, however, no guarantee that an alternate date will be available.

We wish your child all the best for the examination and look forward to meeting parents, carers and students on the day.
